## The 2021 Vintage:

- In the Willamette Valley an arid and warm spring led to an even warmer, drier summer with notable heat spikes.
- The vines remained healthy, and as temperatures cooled in mid-September, harvest was able to stretch out over three smooth weeks, ending in early October.
- After a dramatic growing season, the vines delivered grapes with complex flavors, incredible balance, and layers of elegance.

## **Tasting Notes:**

- A beautiful cuvée. Its lustrous garnet color is immediately striking, and aromatics of summery red cherry, red plum, and light warm spice characters leap from the glass.
- The palate is fresh and fruit-driven to the core.
