Columbia Valley - 96% Syrah, 4% Viognier (co-ferment)

Vineyards: Southwind Estate, Stoney Vine Estate, Stone Tree
Wine Analysis: 6.1 grams/L, Total Acidity, 3.94 pH, 14.7% Alcohol
Techniques: 17% whole cluster. Native yeast fermentation.

Aged on fine lees for 20 months and racked once before bottling.

Oak Program: Aged in 17% new French oak puncheons, 73% neutral oak puncheons.
