



## 2020 Stained Tooth Syrah

Columbia Valley - 97% Syrah, 3% Viognier (co-ferment)

Vineyards: Stoney Vine (Estate), Southwind (Estate), Breezy Slope, Stone Tree

Wine Analysis: 5.6 grams/L, Total Acidity, 3.87 pH, 14.2% Alcohol

**Techniques**: 16-27 day maceration. 12% whole cluster.

Aged on fine lees and racked once before bottling.

Oak Program: Aged in 18% new French oak puncheons

**Production:** 6,300 bottles **UPC:** 856589001002

Winemaker's Notes: Purple is our favorite color. You know you're drinking the good stuff when your teeth develop that unmistaken hue. Don't worry, Chad's father Dr. Dan Johnson D.D.S. says, "life is too short to stain your teeth on bad wine." The Stained Tooth Syrah is sourced from some of Washington State's top vineyards including our Stoney Vine Estate Vineyard on The Rocks and Stone Tree Vineyard on the Wahluke Slope. The bouquet floats out of the glass and draws you into all the extraordinary fruit while the ripe tannins provide a silky finish...

## Jeb Dunnuck 92 Points

A co-fermented blend of 97% Syrah and 3% Viognier, the 2020 Syrah Stained Tooth sports a medium ruby/plum color as well as great nose of ripe black raspberry and blueberry fruit, iron, peppery herbs, and bacon fat. It's medium to full-bodied, has lots of fruit, ripe tannins, and an outstanding finish.
