


2018 Dézaley L'Arbalète Grand Cru AOC

Located in the heart of Lavaux for almost 500 years, the Maison Testuz is now anchored in Vaud's viticulture. Its privileged position in the prestigious Dézaley vineyard, its prominent Vaudois wines and its vast palette of Swiss and world wines have allowed the Maison Testuz to stand out from among some of the largest Swiss wine growers and producers. To produce its



wines, the Maison Testuz cultivates 60 hectares of vines, spread throughout all of the wine-producing regions in Vaud. The vine is worked according to a cultivation method known as "integrated production" that respects the environment and in which the wine maker's work plays a key role. Oak barrels then ensure the perfect development of their specialities.

DESCRIPTION:

- This Swiss-type of vine, Chasselas, represents the best identity of this country, The Chasselas of Moissac cultivated and appreciated its fruit, which is ideally suited to our grounds and climates.
- This vineyard is located on a hill overlooking Lake of Geneva. (Lac Léman)

GRAPE VARIETY:

• 100% Chasselas

Winemaking:

- Traditional winemaking, aging in steel tanks.
- Alcohol content: 13.00% Vol.
- Maturation potential: 2-5 years

FOOD PAIRINGS:

• Fish terrines, Muller's fish, sauce, shellfish, broilers, hard cheese and blue cheese.

TASTING NOTES:

- Eye: Pale yellow.
- Nose: Concentrated and complex, with hints of exotic fruits.
- Palate: Intense, elegant, fruity and floral notes, long-lasting finale with character.

This Swiss Chasselas has aromas of lemon curd, lemon zest and white flowers. In the mouth, it is creamy, with good mouthfeel and flavors of vanilla custard, apple and pear. Dreyfus, Ashby & Co. – J.J. abv: 13%
