# 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon

96% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Petit Verdot

Vineyards: Southwind Estate, Sconni Block Estate, Dionysus, Four Feathers

#### Wine Analysis:

- Total Acidity: 5.7 grams/L
- pH: 3.88.
- Alcohol: 14.7%

**Techniques:** Maceration 14 -27 days tank and bin fermentations.

Aged on fine lees for 20 months and racked once before bottling.

Oak Program:40% new French oak, 5% new Wisconsin oakProduction:21,600 bottlesUPC: 856589001187

#### Winemaker's Notes:

This is just a spectacular Cabernet Sauvignon from the Columbia Valley! This medium bodied wine is both lithe and expressive, with embracing tannins wrapping gently around a focused core of dried herb-accented black cherry and licorice flavors, dancing with finesse on the finish.

### Owen Bargreen - 93 Points

This outstanding 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon has a touch of Petit Verdot (4%) blended in. Anise, dark currants and tar with tobacco leaf aromatics all fill the glass. The palate is superb, showing wonderful refinement, texture and weight, showing off the potential for great red wines made in this warm vintage. Bravo! Drink 2024-2034
