




EDIZIONE PENNINO ZINFANDEL 2020

Edizione Pennino Zinfandel and Primitivo were created in admiration of Francis Coppola's maternal grandfather and namesake, the musician and composer Francesco Pennino. Explore the rich flavors from the renowned Rutherford bench in California, where we source our Zinfandel, to the sun-kissed vineyards of Puglia, Italy, where the Primitivo is carefully selected.

The oldest Zinfandel vines on the historic Inglenook estate are in our Cow Barn, Woodshed, and Carriage blocks, which were planted in 1974 and 1978, and continue to provide the central core of the Pennino blend.




2020 Vintage Notes:

A welcomed rainfall just before bloom set the stage for excellent fruit set for a small 2020 crop. Strong canopy growth offered the fruit protection from the short spells of summer heat as the season progressed toward an early and brief harvest. All fruit was harvested by hand in just under two weeks, commencing August 31st, coincidentally Niebaum's birthday, and concluding on September 10th.

Winemaker's Tasting Notes:

- The 2020 Pennino Zinfandel is a luxurious wine from start to finish.
- The nose is focused with aromas of concentrated deep black fruits and a hint of clove.
- Rich and captivating, the wine envelops the palate with ripe blackberry and black cherry fruit.
- Generous, velvety tannins linger through the finish.
