Walla Walla Valley - 97% Syrah, 3% Viognier (co-ferment)

*The Stained Tooth Syrah is sourced from some of Washington State's top vineyards including two of our Walla Walla Valley estate vineyards – Stoney Vine and Southwind. The bouquet floats out of the glass and draws you into the extraordinary fruit while the ripe tannins provide a silky finish.*



This year Dusted Valley proudly celebrates their 21st anniversary of growing and crafting spectacular Washington State wine under the Dusted Valley and Boomtown by Dusted Valley labels. With strong roots in agriculture, brothers-in-law Chad Johnson and Corey Braunel focus their wine growing philosophies in the vineyard with sustainable practices, low (or modest) yields and minimalistic winemaking. The resulting wines offer a sense of place and showcase their estate vineyards in the Walla Walla Valley and other premier vineyards throughout the state.

Dusted Valley represents our family's quest to fulfill a dream of crafting world-class wine in the Walla Walla Valley. Our estate vineyards yield wines with classic earth, minerality and acid while featuring a freshness true to Washington State terroir. This, combined with our old world techniques and innovative winemaking attitude, result in strong vintages year after year.

- Vineyards:** Stoney Vine Estate; Southwind Estate, Breezy Slope; Stone Tree  
37% Stoney; 29% Breezy; 21% SW; 14% Stone Tree
- Wine Analysis:** 5.2 grams/L, Total Acidity, 3.92 pH, 14.2% Alcohol
- Techniques:** 18% whole cluster. Native yeast fermentation.  
Aged on fine lees for 20 months and racked once before bottling.
- Oak Program:** Aged in 14% new French oak puncheons, 76% neutral oak puncheons.
- Production:** 6,000 bottles
- UPC:** 856589001002
