Vineyards: Southwind Estate, Stone Tree, Dionysus, Four Feathers

Wine Analysis:

- Total Acidity: 5.6 grams/L,
- pH: 3.79
- Alcohol: 14.2%

Techniques: Maceration 14-27 days tank and bin fermentations.
Aged on fine lees for 20 months and racked once before bottling.

Oak Program: 38 new French oak, 4% new Wisconsin oak

Winemaker's Notes:

This is just a spectacular Cabernet Sauvignon from the Columbia Valley! This medium bodied wine is both lithe and expressive, with embracing tannins wrapping gently around a focused core of dried herb-accented black cherry and licorice flavors, dancing with finesse on the finish.
