**Winemaker's Notes:** Our Petite Sirah hails from Stone Tree Vineyard in the heart of the Wahluke Slope AVA and exemplifies the luscious fruit and power that this vineyard is so well known for. Bound by the Columbia River and the Saddle Mountains, the rapid cooling in the evening helps retain naturally high levels of acidity, which in turn preserves the varietal characters of the grape.

## INTERNATIONAL WINE REPORT 91 POINTS

With a dark brooding purple core and a lighter purple rim, the 2021 Stone Tree Petite Syrah from Dusted Valley features aromas and flavors of dark plums, cassis, tobacco leaves, baking chocolate, and forest herbs. Full-bodied with structured tannins and mouthwatering acidity, it is a wine that will need 1-2 years in the bottle to meld together.
