2023 VINTAGE OVERVIEW

A very cool Spring led into a very warm Summer. The heat persisted into August, reducing yields to miniscule volumes. A rich, yet very early, harvest. The pinot noirs are delicate and generous. Low alcohols are a feature. The Rieslings are opulent with great texture and subliminal acidity.

TASTING NOTES:

AROMAS: Stony. Refined. Powerful.

PALATE: Precise. Intense. Racy.

Tightly wound and of crystalline purity, this dry riesling is a very sleek and precise expression of the Okanagan Valley. It has juicy pink grapefruit flavors and a firm, mineral structure that anchors it. There's energy, freshness and spot-on balance in the dynamic finish. Drinkable now, but best from 2026.
