2025 VINTAGE OVERVIEW

The 2025 Touraine vintage is characterized by exceptional quality, precise aromatics, and surprising freshness, despite significantly reduced yields caused by a hot, dry growing season and drought. Across the Loire Valley, winemakers yielded highly concentrated, storybook fruit that retains vibrant natural tension.

- **Growing Season:** An unusually warm, dry spring led to successful budburst and flowering, sparing the region from biting frosts.
- **Harvest:** Harvest occurred earlier than usual, yielding fruit with excellent ripeness.
- **Yields:** Overall production quantities were noticeably down across the appellation, making high-quality bottles highly sought after.

FOOD PAIRING:

A true ambassador of its region, this wine pairs beautifully with Loire Valley goat cheeses such as Valençay, Sainte-Maure de Touraine, and Selles-sur-Cher. It is equally delicious with green asparagus or simply enjoyed as an elegant aperitif.

TASTING NOTES:

The wine reveals a pale color with delicate green reflections. The nose opens with aromas of white flowers, layered with notes of boxwood and exotic fruits. On the palate, freshness and vibrancy are beautifully balanced by citrus and tropical fruit flavors, supported by a saline minerality and subtle bitterness reminiscent of citrus zest. The finish is long, fresh, and mouthwatering, leaving a lingering saline impression.



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
